School Uniform

The school requires that children come clean and neatly dressed. The children wear the following simple uniform:

Winter Uniform

- Grey skirt/pinafore/trousers
- Blue shirt and tie (for Y1-Y6), ties are available from the school office
- Plain blue or school polo shirt (EYFS)
(available from uniform suppliers with school badge)
- Blue jumper, cardigan or sweatshirt
(available from uniform suppliers with school badge)
- Blue and yellow tie

Summer Uniform

- Dress – Gingham Blue
- Blue short-sleeved polo shirt or school polo shirt
(available from uniform suppliers with school badge)
- Grey shorts

Footwear

- Only sensible, black footwear may be worn.
- Boots and trainers are not allowed.

PE Kit

- Blue shorts
- PE t-shirt
(available from uniform suppliers with school badge)
- Black slip on pumps
- Trainers for outside games only.
- Tracksuits/sweatshirts may be used for outside games during the winter months only.
(available from uniform suppliers with school badge)
- Children also need a PE bag which is clearly marked with their name (available from the school office)

School Bags

- Children in EYFS, KS1 and year's 3 and 4 in KS2 are asked to use a school book bag as their schoolbag, these are available from the school office.
- Children in year's 5 and 6 in KS2 may use their own schoolbag.

Jewellery

- Is NOT permitted at any time.
- If children have pierced ears, they will need to have plasters on their ears until the ear has healed, when earrings can then be removed.

Hair

- Long hair should be tied up.
- No extreme hair-styles are allowed, eg, bleach, tram-lines, highlights, spikes etc.
- Please refrain from using hair products.

Ties, book and PE bags are available from the school office. All other branded St Raphael's uniform can be purchased from the School Uniform Shop in Ashton or online from the supplier – a link is available on the school website.

NB: It is important to mark very clearly your child's name on all items of clothing. Any lost uniform is easier to return, if they have a clear name label.
