

**St Raphael's RC Primary School**  
**Measuring the impact of Pupil Premium Grant spending 2011 – 2012**

There were 7 pupils in the St Raphael's Catholic Primary School 2012 cohort entitled to the Pupil Premium Grant. Each child counts as 14%.

The following statistics are based upon their performance at the end of KS2 compared with children receiving the Pupil Premium Grant Nationally.

**SUMMARY**

**Attainment:**

In 2012, KS2 children at St Raphael's, who received Pupil Premium funding, attained higher than those receiving the funding nationally in English but lower in Maths when looking at the Average Point Score. The percentage of pupils to get Level 4 were broadly in line in English (5% below) and approximately one child below in Maths (18%).

**Progress:**

Of those 7 pupils, most made average or better progress in English and maths. In English our results were in line nationally with expected progress. In maths we have approximately one child below national comparison (12%) who did not make the expected progress.
