

**St Raphael's Catholic Primary School
Sports Premium Planned Spend Report
October 2015**



St Raphael's Catholic Primary School receives additional Sports Premium Funding from the government to support additional opportunities and access for all children in school to sporting activities and events.

The purpose of the funding is to improve pupils' lessons in PE and Sport and to provide access to sporting activities outside the planned PE curriculum in order to raise awareness, aspirations, achievement and promote the well-being of these children and to ensure that all children are enthused to participate in exercise long term.

In addition St Raphael's have used the funding to access high quality services and training for the PE leader to deliver a long term legacy in motivating and supporting all staff within the school.

The DfE has provided guidance and on the best ways use Sports Premium and this has been taken into account when budgeting spending for the 2015-2016 academic year, a full breakdown of spend will be provided in the end of year report. As a school we are accountable for reporting on Sports Premium and how this fund will be utilised over the next 12 months.

St Raphael's Sports Premium funding for 2015-16 is currently £3,646.00.

The Leadership Team and Governing Body of the school have decided that the principles underpinning our Sports Premium spend are;

- Summer of Sport – building on the success of 2014/2015 and delivering a festival of sport with outside agencies to provide a wide range of experiences, clubs and skills for the children.
- Audit and purchase of equipment to support the delivery of new sports initiative within school.
- To provide access to quality training for the PE lead within school to further develop their knowledge in order to support all staff within the school.
