Dear Parents and Carers.

Firstly, I hope that you are all keeping safe and well. It has been wonderful to have all the children back in school since schools re-opened fully on 8th March. The children have settled really well back into school life and are working hard. Thank you all for your co-operation on the drive to ensure that the children can enter and leave school in bubbles and with social distancing for everyone on the drive. These measure will remain in place when we return after the Easter break on Wednesday 14th April 2021 and details are available <u>here</u> on the website.

Please find below a few updates for you;



SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMME: As you are aware, we had to postpone the Sacraments of First Forgiveness and First Holy Communion due to take place last year for the children who were then in Year 3 and are currently Year 4. These sacraments will now take place in the Autumn Term when hopefully we will be able to celebrate fully together.

The children will then be in Year 5. The new dates are:

First Forgiveness Wednesday 29th September, 2021 at 6.30pm in St Peter's and St Raphael's Church. First Holy Communion Saturday 16th October, 2021 at 10am in St Peter's and St Raphael's Church.

More details about the preparation of the children and the celebrations will follow. I am sure the celebration of the Sacraments will be even more special.

For children who are currently Year 3 and who would ordinarily be on the Sacramental journey this year they will receive their Sacraments when they are in Year 4. The dates for their Sacraments are;

First Forgiveness Wednesday 9th March, 2022 at 6.30pm in St Peter's and St Raphael's Church. First Holy Communion Saturday 14th May, 2022 at 10am in St Peter's and St Raphael's Church.

LENT & EASTER: The children have observed Lent beautifully in school. The weekly Gospel and assemblies have been posted on Seesaw and Tapestry allowing classes to watch them in their own class bubbles. Also, the Year 6 class have recorded the Stations of the Cross for all classes to follow virtually. Thank you to Year 6 and to Mr Matthews and Miss Gavin for producing this meaningful service.

The Year 6 worship leaders have been busy during Lent. They have worked with Mrs Shields to prepare Collective Worship for each week of Lent that classes have then used in their class bubble. Also, our head girl, Poppy, has introduced a Box of Kindness in each class. The children nominate other children who have done kind deeds during Lent.

YEAR OF ST JOSEPH: Throughout this year the children are looking at the qualities of St Joseph and the events in the Bible involving St Joseph. During Lent the children have been producing work in each class and these will be shared with you virtually.

PARENTS' EVENING: As you are aware due to the closure of schools during this term we decided to postpone Parents' Evening until the summer term. This will allow us to have a period of time with all the children back in school and to complete assessments so that we can discuss progress and targets with you. The new date for Parent's Evening will be the week beginning 17th May, 2021. More details on how this will take place will follow in the Summer Term.

SUMMER TERM EVENTS: We are hoping to be able to do many of our usual end of year events for the children in school and for our Year 6 leavers but obviously at the moment the details for these will depend on any restrictions that are in place at the time. We will keep you informed of events.

YORK 2021: We have contacted Year 5 and 6 parents to advise them that the York trip will not take place. We are currently working to provide a day visit to Rock & River for our Year 6 class.

CLASS PHOTOS: The children will be having class photos on Thursday, 29th April.

SWIMMING LESSONS: School swimming lessons are now allowed to take place and we have the Risk Assessment from Active Tameside to cover this activity. Year 3 and Year 4 will begin swimming lessons in Summer Term 1 and Year 5 and Year 6 will begin swimming lessons in Summer Term 2.

Year 3 and 4 start their lessons on Tuesday 20th April 2021 in the afternoon and will be travelling on a school bus in their class bubble accompanied by school staff. All children will require a one-piece swimming costume or swim shorts and a towel. If your child wears goggles to swim, please provide a note for the swimming instructor. The children do not need to shower gel, deodorant etc. If you have any questions, please contact your class teacher via seesaw.

UNIFORM: The children have returned to school looking very smart. After Easter the summer uniform can be worn.

Summer Uniform

- Grey skirt/pinafore/trousers or grey shorts
- Dress Gingham Blue
- Blue short-sleeved polo shirt or school polo shirt (available from uniform suppliers with school badge)
- Footwear Only sensible, black footwear may be worn. Boots and trainers are not allowed.

Jewellery: is not permitted at any time. (except a watch-not a smartwatch), this covers earrings and includes those covered by plasters.

Hair: Long hair should be tied up, no extreme hairstyles are allowed, e.g., bleach, tramlines, highlights, spikes etc.
