SCHOOL UNIFORM: We know that parents will be purchasing school uniform during the summer holidays ahead of the Autumn Term. Our children always look smart in their uniform. The list of school uniform is below, and I would like to draw your attention in particular to the following;

- In PE children will need plain, navy blue PE shorts not cycling shorts or skorts please.
- Black pumps will be worn for indoor PE and trainers for outdoor PE only.
- Extreme hairstyles, tram lines and dyed hair are not permitted.
- Jewellery, apart from watches, is also not permitted this includes no ear piercings even if covered with plasters or retainers.

- Grey Skirt / Pinafore / Trousers.
- Y1-Y6 Plain Blue Shirt.
- Y1-Y6 Blue and Yellow Tie Rip Tape / Clip or Traditional.
- EYFS Plain Blue Polo Shirt / School Branded Polo Shirt.
- School Branded Blue Jumper / Cardigan

Footwear

- Sensible, closed toe, black shoes only.
- Boots /Trainers /Heels are not allowed.

PE Kit - Reception to Year 6

- Indoor Navy Blue PE Shorts, School Branded Blue PE T-Shirt and Black Pumps.
- Outdoor Years 1-6 Navy Tracksuit/Sweatshirt/Jogging Bottoms, School Branded Blue PE T-shirt and Trainers.
- Children also need a PE bag which is clearly marked with their name.

- Reception Class and Year's 1-4 use a school book bag as their schoolbag.
- Year's 5 and 6 may use their own schoolbag.

END OF YEAR MESSAGES FROM THE SCHOOL OFFICE:

As we reach the end of the academic year;

- Please ensure any outstanding monies are paid via School Money. Any outstanding monies after this time
 will remain on SchoolMoney. In addition, any remaining credit will also transfer. Payments are collected
 online at <u>SchoolMoney</u>.
- Please ensure all payments for Before & After school provision are up to date and any vouchers have been transferred to the end of July. Any debts of 1 month or more may result in your place being paused. Payments are collected online at <u>SchoolMoney</u>.
- Please ensure any outstanding dinner monies are paid by the end of term online at Tameside.
- School Meals in September will start new on day 1, therefore if you are planning on changing this is the best time to do so as after this day the standard two weeks' notice is required. School meals are priced at £2.68 per day currently but this may increase from 1st September 2023.
- The menu for school meals from September can be found here.
- Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will still receive a free meal each day under the UIFSM initiative.
- Children moving into year 3 must now pay for school meals online at Tameside
- If you think you may be eligible for a benefits related Free School Meals please check the criteria and apply online here.
- Nursery Wraparound and 30 Hours Childcare will start from W/C 4th September 2023 for existing children and the 11th September for all new children. Please make sure you have renewed your 30 hour eligibility code before 31.08.2023. All parents need to sign the parental declarations, these will be done in the first few weeks.
- Please return any B&A booking forms of Autumn Term 1 along with a signed copy of the revised terms
 and conditions by Friday 21st July 2023, or at the very latest Thursday 31st August 2023. B&A Bookings
 received after this date may not be processed immediately and therefore, we cannot guarantee places
 in the first week of the new term. Forms are available here.
- The B&A agreement is required from every pupil at the start of each academic year, we ask parents to read this carefully, particularly in relation to cancellations, additional bookings and a new late collection penalty which will be applied from 1st September 2023.
